The Advocate will also sit on, and provide assistance to, the Workplace Health and Safety Committee of the NLEC and any other project or activity as required by Council.

The ideal candidate thrives on developing, writing, presenting and debating positions. The successful candidate is assertive, professional, respectful and skilled at research.

At a minimum the Advocate will possess a Bachelor's Degree with three to five years experience appearing before such quasi-judicial forums as WHSCC External Review or Arbitration Boards. Experience in Workers' Compensation would be considered an asset but is not essential. The Advocate must enjoy working as part of a small team in an employer advocacy organization.
